In conclusion, protecting children requires a strong connection between families, schools, and local authorities to ensure a safer environment for the younger generation.

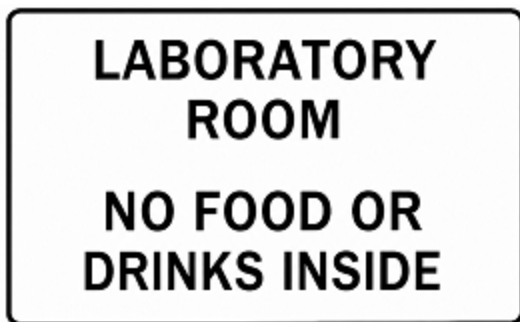
